Building Relationships

Our Vision

We envision academically at-risk children from our community serving productively in our culture, in part, because they've received academic assistance and have come to know the love of God through loving, mutually beneficial relationships facilitated by the Firm Foundation Tutoring Program.



History

In 1993, New City Fellowship of St. Louis (NCF) saw the pressing need to build relationships with the many children who lived in the neighborhood surrounding the church office. It also became evident that many of these children needed help with their homework.

In response, NCF began an after-school tutoring program for children in grades K-6.

Today

In addition to offering after-school tutoring for K-5 students in the West End and Hamilton Heights three days per week during the school year, we also offer tutoring for students in grades 6-12 two evenings a week.

In 2005, we began a tutoring program in South City to immigrant and refugee children that focuses primarily on reading and writing English.

During the summer we also offer a 5-week enrichment program for children in grades K-6 from both areas of the city .

Our Approach

The primary goal of the Firm Foundation Tutoring Program is to build relationships with the children and show them the love of Christ.

Children work one-on-one with volunteers, receiving help with their homework and having a time of devotions. Students who do not bring homework are able to participate in other fun academic activities such as playing games, reading books, and writing stories.

How To Get Involved

Be a tutor! Meet once a week with a child—building a relationship, tutoring, mentoring, and loving him or her.
